

NOTICE TO PARENTS

1. REPORTS

With the end of third term, it is important for parents and students to carefully review students' marks. It is important that your child understands his responsibility in studying and preparing for the end of the year. All third term reports were mailed on Friday, April 9th. If you have not yet received your copy of the report kindly contact the school.

Fourth term reports will be distributed to students on Monday, June 28th.

2. EXAM PERIOD

Last day of classes is June 4th. As of Monday, June 7th students will be writing exams as per the exam schedule that will be given to students. This schedule will also be posted on the school's website.

In addition several exams will also be given in the month of May. These exams, most of them ministerial exams, have the same restrictions as the June exams. All students must be at school on the day and time indicated. Retakes or equivalencies will, when possible, be allowed only for the following reasons: serious illness (with a medical certificate), the death of a close relative or a court summons.

N.B. Kindly remind your child that cell phones are not allowed during exams even if it is to check the time. Invigilators are mandate to void exams if a cell phone is visible.

All students must be in full uniform for exams in May and in June.

3. SUMMER SCHOOL SEC I to SEC III

Registration for summer school will take place on June 29th and 30th. Enclosed you will find information regarding summer school procedures. For students needing summer school, information will also be sent to you with the fourth term report.

Summer school is available in English, mathematics and French. Students may take a maximum of 2 courses providing their final mark in the course is between 50 and 59%.

4. SUPPLEMENTAL EXAMS

Supplemental examinations for Sec IV and V courses will be written between August 2nd and August 6th, 2010. In some courses, preparatory Intensive Courses of 8 days will precede the Supplementals (more information will follow).

5. UNIFORMS (RETURNING STUDENTS ONLY)

I trust that you have carefully read the information pertaining to uniforms that was sent to you with the course selection forms. Please be advised that we will be very strict at all levels in enforcing **ALL** rules regarding the uniforms including gym uniforms. This is particularly true of the pants (NAVY BLUE NOT BLACK). Therefore, it is essential that your child has a proper LDE pants.
